Council Meeting
March 16, 2021

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Rothbury Village Council was opened by President Scott Beishuizen at 7:00 PM in the Village Hall with the recitation of the pledge of allegiance.

Motion by Harris, seconded by Williams to adopt the Local Street Fund Budget as prepared. Motion carried; 7 ayes, 0 nays.

Police Chief Hasper read the monthly report and informed the council that he will be attending the Chief's meetings now that they have resumed. The meetings are attended by Chiefs from 2 counties.

Nancy reported that all is ready for the Easter Egg Hunt on April 3rd. The Easter Bunny is scheduled to arrive at 11 AM with the hunt to follow at 11:30 AM.

Deb Murphy reported to the council that the Brooks family has reserved the RCC for the April 24th memorial for Chief Roland Brooks.

Fekken made a motion, seconded by Talmadge to pay the bills. Motion carried; 7 ayes, 0 nays.
