

Rothbury Village Council Meeting October 20, 2020

The Regularly scheduled meeting of the Rothbury Village Council was opened at 7:30 PM in the Village Hall by President Scott Beishuizen. Members present were; Bob Fulljames, Vern Talmadge, Cindy Cruz, Jim Fekken, Mike Harris, and Autum Drake as well as Treasurer Deb Murphy and Clerk Carol Witzke.

Also present were; Police Chief Tom Hasper, Sargent Ethan Walker, Recreation Director Nancy Rolf, Harold Drake, Barb Thompson, and Cliff Cudney.

The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted by council.

Deb Murphy presented the monthly treasurer's report and updated the council on changes to the Village pension plan.

Trustee Autum Drake asked why the police officers hadn't received a hazardous pay bonus as part of the CARES act. The Clerk and Treasurer explained that it was not a deliberate oversight and that they would do some research to determine if it was too late to apply. Autum supplied the information she had available.

The monthly police report was given by Police Chief Hasper.

Nancy Rolf updated the council on the plans for Halloween and the craft fair.

Deb Murphy informed the council that the school will be using the Community Center for food distribution on Mondays starting November 9th. There was discussion of capacity issues with the COVID restrictions.

Drake made a motion, seconded by Harris to pay the bills. Motion carried, 7 ayes, 0 nays.

There was discussion about the amount of leaves and brush accumulating in the compost pile. Consensus of council to have White Lake Excavating remove excess.

President Beishuizen discussed the bid from Ravenna Sealcoat of \$2663.00 for work on the Village Hall parking lot. Consensus of council to proceed with the project in the Spring.

Meeting stood adjourned at 8:05 PM.
