

Village of Rothbury Council Meeting October 19, 2021

The meeting was opened in the Village Hall by President Scott Beishuizen at 7:00 PM. Council members present were: Cindy Cruz, Vern Talmadge, Brandy Williams, Jim Fekken, and Mike Harris. Autumn Drake was absent due to illness.

Also in attendance were: Treasurer Deb Murphy, Police Chief Tom Hasper, Sgt. Ethan Walker, Recreation Director Jessica Beggs, Grant Township Trustee Joan Brooks, Planning Commissioner Domo Cruz, Barbara Thompson, and Cliff Cudney.

The corrected minutes were accepted after the pledge of allegiance.

Deb Murphy reported on activities at the Community Center.

Scott Beishuizen reported on sidewalk repair work to be performed before the weather turns too cold.

Carol Witzke reported that grant paperwork had been submitted for a new well at the Village Hall.
